- The divers can freely choose the dives from the dive table given in the <u>World Aquatics Handbook</u>.
- **Age group 16 69\* years.** Each dive performed must have a different dive number according to the <u>World Aquatics Handbook</u>.
- **Age group 70 80+\* years.** Dives with the same dive number can be repeated, if performed in a different position: straight, tuck, pike or free position. This will be counted as a different dive and will receive full DD.
- **Dives without rotation (jumps) (Dive No 'x00') may not be used.** This does not apply to 600A used on platform as it is a recognised World Aquatics dive.

- Novices may not perform dives of more than 1.5 rotations or with tariff over 2.0 from the dive table given in the <u>World Aquatics Handbook</u>.
- One dive many be repeated, but at 1.0 tariff.
- **Dives without rotation (jumps) (Dive No 'x00') may not be used.** This does not apply to 600A used on 5m as it is a recognised World Aquatics dive.

#### SYNCHRO COMPETITION

- **You can only enter the synchro event once,** i.e. you can either compete in the Up to 99 1m synchro event <u>or</u> in the 100+ 1m synchro event, but not in both.
- You can synchro with same sex or different sex divers.
- Separate medals will be awarded for pairs with a combined age of up to 99 years and pairs with a combined age of 100+. The ages of both divers must be added together to ascertain which category to enter, i.e. a pair consisting of an 18-year-old and a 50-year-old would dive in the Up to 99 age group.
- On all synchro dives, the divers must dive in the same direction. Any dives with the same number but in a different position are classed as a repeat (except if one of the divers in the pair is from the 70 80+ age groups).
- There is no tariff limit. Except that when one of the pair is a novice diver, they may not perform dives of more than 1.5 rotations or with a World Aquatics tariff over 2.0.


### SOCIAL
